

Remote Learning at OAJW - Acceptable Use Agreement

To make sure that students get the most out of remote learning*, students and parents must agree to meet the below expectations.

Expectations for students	Expectations for parents
<p>While I am taking part in live remote learning, I agree to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Get ready to learn – make sure I have my equipment ready. • Try and find somewhere quiet where I can concentrate on my learning. • Only access lessons for my own classes. • Before a lesson starts, ensure my microphone is muted. • Listen carefully to my teacher so that I know what to do. • Work hard and remember to respect the efforts of others taking part in the lesson. • If I have a question for my teacher, or I need support during a live lesson, use the hands up and chat functions to let them know. • Remember OAJW lesson expectations: I should follow the expectations for behaviour and working throughout each lesson. • Never record a lesson. <p>When using Microsoft Teams, I agree to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only use it to access learning (such as homework and resources from missed lessons) and participate in live lessons. • Not share inappropriate content or content that is not related to my learning. • Not use Teams to disrupt the learning of others in any way. <p>I understand that failure to meet the expectations above will result in sanctions.</p>	<p>While my child is taking part in remote learning I agree to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Supervise them as appropriate. • Support my child to be able to complete their lessons as much as possible in a room where they can concentrate without distractions. • Support my child to learn by ensuring that they have appropriate equipment ready (pen, exercise book etc.) • Minimise background noise and be aware that it can be picked up on my child's microphone. • Ensure that my child understands that recording of the sessions in any way is prohibited. • Ensure that my child understands that Teams is only to be used for learning and should not be used for sharing other content or disrupting the learning of others.

*Remote learning includes homework, live lessons, and access to resources from missed lessons.
